Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.338 dated 17.09.2021 registered under Sections 21(b), 27A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, district Fatehabad.

Through CRM-M No.40573 of 2021 – Sukhdev Singh @ Bittu Vs. State of Haryana the petitioner had earlier approached this Court for the grant of anticipatory bail, which petition of his was dismissed on 28.09.2021 through the following order :-

“The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench

and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner, at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

The only change in the circumstance occasioning the filing of the present petition is the grant of bail by the Trial Court to co-accused Sharwan but since co-accused Sharwan has been granted regular bail and the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail, such stand does not support the petitioner's case.

Dismissed.
