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**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.102 dated 20.10.2020, under Sections 313, 376(2)(n), 376(2)(f), 420, 406, 506 of IPC and Section 66(E), 67(A) of I.T. Act 2000 and Section 3 (2) (v) of SC and ST Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989 added later on, registered at Police Station Women Jind, District Jind.

By virtue of the orders dated 13.01.2021/28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the bar under Section 18 of the Act is applicable to the petitioner. Hence, no ground for the grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

A perusal of file shows that this Court vide order dated 13.01.2021, the petitioner was granted interim bail subject to the condition under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C. However, the offences under Section 3(2)(v) of SC & ST Prevention of Atrocities Act were also incorporated later on and vide order dated 28.01.2022 he was again allowed interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Geeta has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above observations, the interim orders dated 13.01.2021/28.01.2022, are made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
