Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 219 dated 26.03.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal.

At this stage, Mr. Sudhir Rana, Advocate, appears and filed vakalatnama on behalf of the petitioner with no objection from the earlier counsel. The vakalatnama is taken on record.

Vide order dated 21.01.2022 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 21.01.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Lakhbir Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.01.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
