1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-858-2018, was disposed of by directing the respondent to take a decision on representations dated 01.11.2017 and 17.11.2017, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that decision has been taken on the aforesaid representations vide order dated 05.04.2019, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
