1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 26.02.2018, in CWP-4569-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 26.02.2018, reveals that CWP-4569-2018 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 09.12.2017, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case on consideration the competent authority arrived at the conclusion that the benefits claimed by the petitioners were admissible, to release the same to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the petition, claim of the petitioner has been accepted vide order dated 12.07.2022, and appointment letter issued to the petitioner and

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
