Status report by way of an affidavit of Jatinder Jit Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dakha, District Ludhiana(Rural) has been filed by learned State counsel on behalf of the respondent today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 12.01.2022, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.01.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel. However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail. He further submits that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

5. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.
6. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 12.01.2022, is hereby made absolute.
