The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondent No.2 and 3 to remove the illegal encroachment by respondent No.4 and 5 in Panchayat Kallah/Drainage.

The petitioner claims that respondent No.4 and 5 have included the land of the drain in their own land. The learned counsel representing the petitioner further states that the respondents are not taking any action.

Mr. Ayush Sarna, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, enters appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and 3 and on instructions from Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Phillaur, states that demarcation of the land is being carried out and the competent authority will decide on the future course of action on the basis of the said demarcation.

At this stage, the learned counsel representing the petitioner

prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition in view of the statement of the learned State counsel.

Ordered accordingly.
