Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.00639 dated 29.09.2021 registered under Sections 384, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sector-7, Faridabad, Haryana, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.01.2022, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel has argued that as per complainant and other victim, the alleged demand of money was made by co-accused Sunil @ Bijju Chandila, who came alone to his shop on a motorcycle to ask for money. He has pointed out that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Sunil @ Bijju Chandila, therefore, in these given facts, his custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

Notice of motion for 07.07.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by SI Mohd. Raffik, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.01.2022 is made absolute.
