Main case

With the consent of the learned counsel representing the parties, the main case is taken on Board.

Complaining wilful violation of the directions issued on 11.02.2016 passed in CR-6242-2004, the present petition for initiation of the proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 has been filed.

The operative part of the order dated 11.02.2016 reads as under:-

“The only benefit I can give to the Union is to spare the cost and allow for enforcement of the decree as appropriate by invoking the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227, the power that was invoked by Division Bench of this Court in Gurbachan Kaur's case (supra).

The amount shall be calculated and released to the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.

It must be remembered that the persons who participated in the freedom struggle could be just a handful and their numbers could be counted.

The relief must come to the petitioner during his lifetime as a mark of respect to a brave soldier who fought for the country's freedom.

The revision petition is allowed on the above terms.”

While filing reply, it has been disclosed that the payment alongwith interest in compliance with the orders by the Supreme Court, has already been released to the petitioners.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
