Short reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed. The same is taken on record.

2. By way of the present petition, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of direction to release vehicle No.HR-66B 2656 on superdari. The said vehicle already stands released and the said fact finds mentioned in para 4 of the status report which reads as under:-

“4. That it is pertinent to mention here that an FIR No.222/2021 has already been lodged in Police Station, City Narnaul on 19.03.2021. Translated copy of the F.I.R. is attached herewith as **Annexure R-2**. It is also pertinent to mention here that the Hon'ble Trial court has passed the superdari on 08.04.2021 in the matter of said vehicle. Copy of superdari order passed by Ld. CJM, Narnaul is attached herewith as **Annexure R-3**.

3. Mr. Jain submits that order passed by CJM, Narnaul releasing the said vehicle on superdari is appended as Annexure R-3.

4. Consequently, he submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
5. Owing to the fact that the vehicle already stands released on superdari vide order dated 08.04.2021 passed by CJM, Narnaul (Annexure R-3), nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition.
6. Disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
