This petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer to set aside the order dated 12.02.2016, passed by the learned SDJM, Sub Division Balachaur, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person in FIR No.91 dated 15.07.2015 registered under sections 406, 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

Feeling aggrieved, the accused has come up before this Court on the ground that now the matter has been compromised and compounding of offences has been allowed qua the co-accused.

Given the facts and circumstances peculiar to this case, the petition is allowed.

Consequently, the impugned order dated 12.02.2016 for declaring the petitioner a proclaimed person, is set aside qua the petitioner, subject to the condition that he shall appear before the trial Court either within 30 days or on actual date fixed by the Court below, which is earlier.
