SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

On 11.01.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Heard through video conferencing.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.194 dated 20.08.2019 under Sections 308, 315, 323, 498-A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are the in-laws of the complainant and the allegations against them are of instigating their son to hit the complainant, which resulted in the abortion of fetus. Counsel submits that

petitioner No.1 was arrested on 20.08.2019 and after a detailed enquiry, no material was found against him. He submits that the petitioners have been summoned as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and they are not required for custodial interrogation. He has instructions to state that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Prabhjot Singh Walia, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Let the petitioners surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and join the proceedings. In case, they do so and move an application seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall release them on interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds/sureties to its satisfaction.

List on 15.03.2022.”

Counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the above reproduced order, petitioners have surrendered before the Trial Court on 24.01.2022 and have been ordered to be released on interim bail. He has placed on record a copy of the order dated 24.01.2022 passed by the Trial Court.

In view of the above, order dated 11.01.2022 is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of.
