Through the present criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners prays for a writ in the nature of mandamus to be issued to direct respondents No.2 to 4 to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents who are making every attempt to usurp the land of the petitioners herein. It is submitted that a representation/complaint dated 07.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) in this regard has already been preferred, however, the same has not been decided. The petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

At this stage, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and would submit that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to take a decision on the representation dated 07.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
