At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would be surrendering before the trial Court within one week positively and would be moving an appropriate application for seeking the relief of regular bail there and he further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the said bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Ms. Ishneet Kaur, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in

advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one week from today and moves any application for seeking the relief of regular bail there, then the same shall be decided within four days.
