This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 258, dated 29.04.2021, registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 408/419/420/467/468/471 of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 03.02.2022, the report of the learned SDJM, Indri, dated 10.02.2022 has been received, essentially stating to the effect that despiteailable warrants also having been issued to secure the presence of the three prosecution witnesses, they have not appeared for the past few dates of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that the complainant in the FIR is Sumer Chand, and with it seen from the report of the learned trial court that even he has not been appearing before that court to testify.

At this stage, learned counsel for the State submits that as per his instructions the complainant stands examined on 25.02.2022.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
