Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 12 and for conducting fair, proper and impartial inquiry in case FIR No.163, dated 14.10.2020, under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal through some independent senior police officer or independent agency.

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 12.01.2021, pursuant to which a reply dated 12.07.2021 by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Hargobindpur, Police District, Batala, District Gurdaspur, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4..

Learned State counsel refers to paragraphs 4 and 7 of the reply to submit that challan in this case has been presented in the concerned Court and the case is now fixed for recording prosecution evidence.
