This is an application for placing on record the reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 is taken on record.

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the transfer order dated 30.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner along with consequent relieving orders dated 31.12.2021 (Annexures P-7 and P-8).
