1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.07.2016, in CWP-14048-2016

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 29.07.2016, reveals that while issuing notice of motion for 02.09.2016, status quo was ordered to be maintained till the next date of hearing.

3. Although the contempt petition is of the year 2016, yet no notice has been issued to the respondent till date.

4. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that dispute between the parties as was the subject matter of CWP-14048-2016, has been settled amicably and the payment as mutually agreed upon, has been made to the erstwhile State Bank of Patiala (now State Bank of India), therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
