[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 04.05.2018 in CWP No.11195 of 2018.

[2] Notice was issued in the instant case on 21.11.2018 returnable by 07.01.2019 to show cause as to why contempt proceedings be not initiated against the respondent. On 07.01.2019, in view of office report that notice could not be issued to the respondent as learned counsel for the petitioner had not filed process fee, the matter was adjourned to 03.04.2019 while granting last opportunity to learned counsel for the petitioner to file process fee within one week with the rider that in case needful was not done, the contempt petition would stand dismissed. On 11.02.2020, counsel for the petitioner stated that process fee could not be filed as he was not aware about the details of incumbent posted as Chief Engineer, PSPCL, Central Zone, Ludhiana whereupon while issuing fresh notices for 02.07.2020 process fee was ordered to be filed within two weeks along with particulars of the respondent while observing that in

case of non-compliance of the order, the petition be deemed dismissed without being listed.

[3] As per office noting dated 17.05.2022, fresh notice could not be issued to the respondent for 02.07.2020 for want of process fee.

[4] None is present on behalf of the petitioner nor has any request for pass-over or adjournment been made. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition.

[5] Dismissed for non-prosecution.
