JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition that has been filed for grant of parole for 04 weeks to the petitioner to attend marriage of his elder brother, which is fixed for 05/06.02.2022.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner has been convicted and sentenced under Sections 399 and 402 IPC for a period of 12 years on 17.08.2018 in FIR No.28 dated 11.03.2015 registered at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, out of which he has already undergone 9 years and 6 months. CRA-D-5-DB-2019 has been filed to challenge the said conviction and sentence. It is submitted that the petitioner was also involved in another FIR No.17 dated 05.02.2014 registered under Sections 382, 457, 395 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Mataur and has been sentenced therein for 7

years on 20.01.2020, out of which he has undergone 3 years and 5 months of actual sentence of imprisonment. CRA-S-872-SB-2020 has been filed against said conviction and sentence. It is further submitted that there is a panchayatnama, available on the record as Annexure P-3, wherein Gram Panchayat Village Manakpur Kallar has recommended petitioner's release for a period of 8 weeks and that there is no apprehension of any kind of danger. Panchayatnama also ensures that petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities in a time bound manner.

Counsel for the respondent-State would submit that factum of marriage of petitioner's brother has been verified.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner is directed will be released on parole for a period of two weeks on his execution of adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the authority concerned, so as to enable him to attend the marriage of his elder brother stated for 05/06.02.2022.
