1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 09.05.2017, CWP-17973-2016, in case titled as Nirmal Singh vs. Union of India and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 09.05.2017, reveals that CWP-17973-2016, was disposed of by directing the competent authority to consider the application of the petitioner for renewal of Certificate of Practice as Notary by taking into consideration the proviso to Rule 8-B, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and to issue license in respect thereto in case the requirement of law had been complied with.

3. Learned Additional Solicitor General of India assisted by Mr. Sunil Kumar Sharma, Advocate, states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1 dated 09.05.2017, needful has been done and notary

certificate renewed and issued to the petitioner vide order Annexure R/2 dated 13.04.2022.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the needful having been done, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
