[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.03.2019, in CWP-24469-2018 in case titled as '**Jugraj Singh and others versus The State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that the CWP-24469-2018 was disposed of in view of the statement of the learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, that the case of the petitioners would be considered within two months in the light of decision in '**State of Punjab and others versus Jagjit Singh and others**', LPA No.37 of 2017, decided on 25.09.2018.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of fresh decision having been taken on the claim of the petitioners in the light of decision in **Jagjit Singh's** case (*supra*) vide order dated 20.03.2021, the petitioners do not wish to press the instant petition, therefore, the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 20.03.2021 by way of appropriate

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
