AJAY TEWARI, J.(Oral)

1. By this petition the petitioner as prayed for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to release goods along with conveyance on furnishing security other than cash or bank guarantee.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this regard an appeal has also been filed which is already lying pending. He further states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said appeal.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Vermani, Addl. A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to this due course of action.
5. In these circumstances, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the appeal by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of 15 days from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order. For this purpose, the petitioner is directed to appear before respondent No.2 on 21.1.2022 and on any other date when its presence is required.

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
