[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 02.04.2018, in CWP No.18238 of 2015 in case titled as '**Sukhdev Singh and others** versus **The Punjab Mandi Board and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No. 18238 of 2015, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for promotion under the new rules on the same analogy on which respondent No.7 had been promoted with needful to be done within 06 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel for the respondent refers to reply dated 05.03.2019 and 23.05.2022, as also promotion order (Annexure R-2) dated 08.01.2021, promoting the petitioners to the post of Supervisor.

[4] Reply dated 23.05.2022 is taken on record. The same bears

an endorsement of learned counsel for the petitioners having received copy thereof.

[5] None is present on behalf of the petitioners. For that matter, none was present on behalf of the petitioners on 16.05.2022 and 23.05.2022.

[6] In view of order (Annexure R-2) dated 08.01.2021, promoting the petitioners by taking a decision on the claim for consideration in terms of order dated 02.04.2018 in CWP No.18238 of 2015, no action is called for against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[7] The instant petition is accordingly *disposed of* as such.
