The petitioner's application under Order I Rule 10 with a prayer to add him as defendant in a suit for declaration filed by the plaintiff with letter dated 06.04.2018, issued by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited is illegal and void has been dismissed. The Court has noticed that the plaintiff has not claimed any relief against the petitioner.

This Bench has heard the learned counsel representing the parties at some length and with their able assistance perused the paperbook.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that letter dated 06.04.2018, has been issued on the complaint of the petitioner, therefore the petitioner is a proper party. This Court has considered the submissions, however, finds no merit therein. The plaintiff while filing the suit has sought declaration that letter memo No.458 dated 06.04.2018, is illegal, null and void. In such suit, no relief against the applicant has been sought. Hence, the trial Court has correctly held that the petitioner is not a

necessary party.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
