Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance for quashing of the FIR No.40 dated 27.04.2020 under Sections 452, 379-B, 323, 148, 149, 188, 269 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 379-B and 452 deleted and Section 325 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 added later on) (later on added Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897) registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners points out that during the pendency of the instant petition, proceedings have culminated into acquittal of the petitioners. She thus submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
