1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 04.12.2007, in CWP-11999-1998.

2. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the issuance of notice, the respondents have arrived at an amicable settlement in terms of Annexure P-1 dated 04.12.2007, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
