LISA GILL, J.

This writ petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 04.06.2014 (Annexure P1) passed by learned Collector, District Mahendergarh at Narnaul; order dated 13.09.2019 (Annexure P3) passed by learned Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram and order dated 28.10.2020 (Annexure P4) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana whereby suit filed by the petitioner under Section 13A of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (as applicable to the State of Haryana) (for short – ‘the Act’), appeal under Section 13 AA of the Act and revision, respectively were dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on 04.02.2022 was afforded time to place on record to revenue entries/records to substantiate the contention as has been made in the suit filed under Section 13A of the Act. The matter was adjourned on numerous occasions at request for compliance, including last

opportunity being afforded. Cost of Rs.5,000/- was also imposed on 20.07.2022, when order dated 04.02.2022 had not been complied with despite last opportunity and yet more time was sought to do the needful within four weeks. Cost has not been paid and neither relevant documents placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that relevant documents have not been provided by the petitioner and he has no instructions from the petitioner.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
