The present petition has been filed raising a grievance that while conducting investigation in FIR No. 519 dated 17.12.2021, registered under Sections 20, 61 and Section 85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Hodal, the petitioners are being harassed though, according to the petitioners, they have not been arrayed as accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are not evading law and are ready to join the investigation, if needed by the police but for the said purpose, the provision as envisaged under Cr.P.C. should be followed.
