Prayer in the instant application is for disposal of the main writ petition as infructuous.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits in the main writ petition challenge was to a notice of re-assessment dated 31.03.2021 served upon the petitioner under Section 148 of the Income Tax Act on 01.04.2021.

The writ petition had been adjourned sine die to await the decision in case titled as Union of India and others vs Ashish Agarwal bearing Civil Appeal No. 3005 of 2022 pending before the Apex Court.

It has been averred in the instant application that Hon'ble the Supreme Court has decided the matter on 04.05.2022 and the Income Tax Department has been directed to issue fresh notices to the assessee concerned under Section 148A(b). Towards compliance of the directions issued by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, the petitioner has been issued a fresh

notice dated 02.06.2022 under Section 148A(b). It is contended that by virtue of such subsequent development, the challenge to the validity of the previously issued notice dated 31.03.2021 does not survive.

Issue notice in the application.

Mr. Vaibhav Gupta, Junior Standing Counsel for the Income Tax Department, who is present in Court, accepts notice.

Copy of the application already stands supplied.

With the consent of the counsel for the parties, the main writ petition i.e. CWP No. 758 of 2022 is segregated from the bunch and is taken up for hearing today itself.

The application stands disposed of.

Main case

Counsel for the petitioner makes a statement at the bar that after filing of the writ petition, the Income Tax Department has issued fresh notice dated 02.06.2022 under Section 148A(b) and pursuant to such notice, the petitioner has participated in the proceedings.

Counsel for the petitioner accordingly submits that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
