The petitioner seeks a direction to the official respondents not to entertain enquiry after enquiry on the same subject at the behest of private respondent No.7, against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Hardeep Singh, DSP, Sub Division Payal, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, which is taken on record. The relevant extracts of Para 2 of the said status report reads as under:-

It is most respectfully submitted that Superintendent of Police (I), Khanna, conducted the inquiry on the application moved by the respondent No.7. The statement of respondent No.7 and others were recorded and the record has been looked into and it is found that there is a dispute between both the parties regarding the money. Already the matter regarding the money was pending before the Hon'ble Court, Ludhiana as such no police proceedings is required. Hence, the application moved by the respondent No.7 suggested to be consigned in record

room. That detailed report prepared by SP(I) dated 24.02.2020 has been submitted before Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna (respondent No.5) who wrote on the same as “seen and file” on 01.03.2020 as such the application dated 09.12.2019 moved by respondent No.7 against the petitioner was consigned to record room...”

A perusal of the above extract of the aforesaid affidavit clearly demonstrates that now no complaint is pending and even the present complaint has been examined and the same has been consigned to the record room.

In the light of the above situation, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, which renders the present petition as infructuous.

Disposed of, accordingly.
