1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 27.08.2021 in CWP-1661-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 27.08.2021, reveals that CWP-16661-2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 15.03.2021 and take a conscious decision on the same by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant case.

4. Learned Counsel contends that as per Annexure R-2 dated 15.04.2022 claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 15.03.2021 has been rejected and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order Annexure R-2 dated 15.04.2022 by

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
