Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to transfer the investigation to higher police official to conduct fair and unbiased investigation in a case bearing FIR No.25 dated 13.08.2021, under Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 363, 366 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Women Police Station Mewat, District Nuh, with further prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, his victim daughter and his family at the hands of accused persons by taking action on the representation dated 10.09.2021 (Annexure P-2).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she may be allowed to withdraw her first prayer *qua* transfer the investigation to higher police official to conduct fair and unbiased investigation with liberty to avail the remedy before the trial Court.

Permitted to do so. Thus, this petition survives only *qua* the second

prayer regarding granting protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner, his victim daughter and his family members.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Vishal Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has filed representation dated 10.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) before the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh, for the redressal of his claim and no decision thereon has been taken so far.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh, to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty to the petitioners, if any, and take necessary action accordingly.
