AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

These petitions are filed seeking regular bail to the petitioners in case of FIR No. 55 dated 26.4.2020 under Sections 213, 166A, IPC, 1860, Sections 21/15/20/59 (2) of NDPS Act, 1985 (Sections 7, 8, 13(1) B of PC Act Amended 2018 and Sections 61/01/14 of Excise Act, 1914 added later on) registered at P.S. STF Phase-IV, SAS Nagar, Mohali during the

pendency of the trial.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Puran Singh submits that charges against the petitioners have been framed, two prosecution witnesses were examined and two given up. The complainant is yet to be examined.

There cannot be dispute on the issue that in cases with such like allegations as in present case, endeavour of the prosecution should be to examine the complainant at priority.

Learned counsel for State submits that an earnest effort would be made to examine the material witnesses including the complainant at the earliest.

In view of the statement made by the learned State Counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners seek permission to withdraw the petitions at this stage.

Petitions are dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case a request is made before the Trial Court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the witnesses, there is no doubt that the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

Since the main cases have been decided, the prayer in pending application, if any, render infructuous.
