Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.144 dated 21.07.2020, registered for offences under Sections 188, 341, 147, 148, 149, 354, 354-A, 308 and 395 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of affidavit, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Although, report has been received from the Trial Court pursuant to order passed by this Court, but in view of the observations of the Supreme Court in *The State of Madhya Pradesh Versus Laxmi Narayan and others 2019 (5) SCC 688*, the present petition cannot be entertained, moreso, as the quashing is being sought solely on the basis of an affidavit allegedly executed by the complainant, without the other two victim being a party thereto.

Petition is dismissed.
