[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 01.06.2017 in CWP No.12673 of 2017 in case titled as M/s New Satluj Transport Company Regd. Mansa through its Managing Partner vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.12673 of 2017 was disposed of by directing consideration of the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice i.e. Annexures P/4 and P/5 by the Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda and to pass a speaking order in respect thereto within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Application i.e. CM No.7076-CII of 2019 in the instant case has been moved for placing on record reply by way of affidavit of the Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda along with Annexures R/1 to R/5. The same is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of orders Annexures R/1 to R/5, needful has been done, therefore the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[6] Rule discharged.

[7] This order shall also dispose of all pending misc. applications.
