The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to disburse the State Capital Subsidy of Rs. 2,91,000/- sanctioned to the petitioner in respect of its unit vide letter (Annexure P-1) alongwith interest @ 6% per annum.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that it was proprietorship and that now the petitioner is operating the proprietorship firm and that he is ready and willing to furnish an undertaking to indemnify in the event of any counter claim being raised.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instruction from Ajaib Singh, Senior Assistant contends that in the event of the petitioner submitting an affidavit and indemnity, and also details of the account wherein the capital subsidy is to be released,

the same shall be transferred to his account within a period of 04 weeks of submission of the affidavit/indemnity.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has no surviving cause of action. The present petition is accordingly disposed of in view of the statements recorded above. Needless to mention that the respondent-authorities shall remained bound by the statement made today in the Court.
