This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for granting regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.192 dated 23.08.2021 registered under Section 304 IPC (converted from offence under Section 302 IPC) at Police Station City Kotakpura, District Faridkot.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case neither the doctor nor the last seen witnesses namely Neetu Singh and Fakir Singh have been examined as yet, although charges have been framed on 23.12.2021.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition for regular bail after examination of said three witnesses. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the trial Court be directed to first examine the said three witnesses as expeditiously as

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition after the above said three witnesses are examined.

The State of Punjab is directed to examine said three witnesses at the first instance. The trial Court is also requested to examine said witnesses as expeditiously as possible. The accused is also directed to cooperate with the trial Court in recording the statements of said witnesses.
