1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 14.07.2021, in CWP-12645-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-12645-2021, was disposed of vide order dated 14.07.2021, by directing the competent authority to take final decision on legal notice dated 09.05.2021, on petitioner submitting relevant documents in respect thereto, with needful to be done within two months and payment, if found due to the petitioner, be released to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1 dated 14.07.2021, in CWP-12645-2021, the competent authority has decided the claim made in legal notice dated 09.05.2021 and released payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition

and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
