1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.11.2021, in CWP-24135-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-24135-2021, was disposed of by directing respondent No.5 to consider and decide representation dated 04.08.2021, filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if conclusion was arrived at that the petitioner was entitled for the amount in question, then the same be paid forthwith and in the event of any delay, respondent No.5 would be liable to make payment of interest @ 6% per annum for the delayed payment w.e.f. the date the amount became due till its final realization.

3. Learned counsel contends that although payment of principal amount has been made yet no interest has been paid on the ground that there is no delay in making the payment. Learned counsel contends that in

the circumstances the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge the action of respondent No.5 holding the petitioner not entitled to payment of interest for the delayed payment, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. The same is not opposed to by the learned AAG, Punjab.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent No.5 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
