[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 28.10.2021 in CRM-M No.45169 of 2021.

[3] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.10.2021 reveals that CRM-M No.45169 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to look into representation dated 13.10.2021 submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in respect thereto accordance with law within two weeks.

[4] Pursuant to issuance of notice of motion, learned AAG has placed on record copy of reply dated 08.03.2022 along with orders, Annexure R/1 dated 21.12.2021 deciding the representation dated

petitioner. Learned AAG states that pursuant thereto FIR No.103 dated 22.10.2022 under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Ludhiana has been registered against the husband of the petitioner, therefore, in view of orders dated 28.10.2021 in CRM-M No.45169 of 2021 having been complied with, no action is called for against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[5] Learned counsel for the petitioner also states that in view of the position noted above, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[6] In the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents.

[7] Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
