Vide this application, advancement of the date of hearing in the accompanying petition is sought with learned counsel submitting that two co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Abhishek @ Harphool and Vikas @ Kaluwa, have been admitted to interim bail by this court, upon them having filed CRM-M Nos. 38458 and 44780 of 2021, respectively.

A perusal of the order passed in the first case (copy Annexure P-3), shows that the petitioner was admitted to interim bail, on the ground that the recovery of stolen pigs had already been made but with learned State counsel having sought time to take instructions as to whether that had actually been done or not.

Learned State counsel today submits that as per his instructions, the recovery of the pigs has been made.

That being so, this application is allowed and the date of hearing in the accompanying petition is advanced to today itself.

CRM-M-1238-2022

This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 177, dated 14.08.2021, registered at Police Station Titram, District Kaithal, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 380/457 of the IPC (with Section 411 of the IPC having been added later).

In view of the above, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, with the petitioner having been in custody since 16.08.2021 and it being a Magisterial trial, looking at the nature of offences alleged to have been committed, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
