This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents for releasing the petitioner prematurely.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of Union of India has submitted that vide order dated 03.11.2022 passed by the General, Chief of the Army Staff, the prayer of the petitioner has been accepted and he has been ordered to be prematurely released.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present Criminal Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such with liberty to

the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives to the petitioner.

In view of the same, the present Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

Learned State Counsel is directed to inform about the passing of order dated 03.11.2022 by the General, Chief of the Army Staff, which has been referred to by the learned counsel for Union of India, to the concerned Superintendent of Police, Central Jail, Amritsar and Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
