1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.08.2019, in CWP-23212-2019.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P-1 dated 29.08.2019, reveals that CWP-23212-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide representation dated 12.03.2019, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to monetary benefits pursuant to decision of the legal notice, the same was ordered to be paid to him within three months thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 27.10.2022, giving details of payment released to the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in the

circumstances he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 27.10.2022, to claim benefits which he is entitled to but which have not been released to him as per his entitlement, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
