1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.03.2019, in CWP-6155-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-6155-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 07.03.2019, in view of the stand of the learned State counsel that legal notice dated 06.10.2018, served by the petitioners would be examined by the competent authority and decision in respect thereto taken, within three months.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 28.08.2020, rejecting the claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 06.10.2018, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 28.08.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to petitioners, as prayed for.
