Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.121 dated 02.10.2019 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana on the basis of a written compromise dated 30.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the petitioner and respondent No.2.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 denies any compromise between the petitioner and his client.

This is the second consecutive occasion when none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

In the light of the afore statement made on behalf of respondent No.2, no merit is found in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.

It is clarified that the dismissal of the present petition shall not preclude the petitioner from challenging the impugned FIR on merits.
