

- (i) *that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) *that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) *that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”*

Upon instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 12.01.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
