Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case criminal complaint bearing No.COMI-198 of 2019 dated 15.7.2019, under Sections 3 & 4 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes Act, 1989, titled as Mithu Singh Vs. Jasbir Singh and others, whereby the petitioner alongwith other co-accused have been summoned by the JMIC, Bathinda to face trial under Sections 354, 323, 506 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes Act, 1989 vide order dated 4.1.2020.

By virtue of the order dated 12.1.2022, the petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail on his appearance before the trial Court.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail. As he is continuously appearing before the trial Court, so the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.1.2022 is made absolute.

The petitioner will keep on continuously appearing before the trial Court during the trial.

The petition stands allowed.
