Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.175 dated 07.08.2021 under Sections 379-A, 411, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Krishna, when she was going to home, two unknown persons met her and asked to give her mobile phone, as they had no money to talk someone. Later on, they took her mobile phone and Rs.1,000/-, which she was keeping in her hand. It is further stated that after snatching the

mobile phone and money, they were going ahead and she was following them. After some time, they reached near a Dhaba, where again they snatched a pair of gold earrings and then they fled away. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 05 months and 11 days; he is first offender; he is not involved in any other case and the investigation is complete. It is also submitted that after arrest of the petitioner, no recovery was effected from him.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 05.04.2022 in the Court today and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
