The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing respondents to refix and pay full retiral dues after granting the benefit of Bunching to the petitioners as is payable in accordance with the notification dated 16.01.1998 with all other consequential benefits with arrears and interest, for which, legal notice dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P/7) and representation dated 11.02.2021 have also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-7) and representation dated 11.02.2021 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.
